Dear ECNU Student.

Greetings from Cincinnati.

As a student majoring in Geographic Science and Geographic Information Sciences in the School of Geographical Sciences at East China Normal University (ECNU), the credits you earn now can count towards a dual bachelor's degree at both ECNU and the University of Cincinnati (UC). By participating in the UC and ECNU 2+2 undergraduate degree program, you can be guaranteed admission into UC upon successful completion of >55% of your course credits required for your BS degree in ECNU with a grade point average (GPA) of >3.0 on a 4 point scale and a TOEFL score of >66. For those students who have garnered a cumulative GPA of >3.25 and a TOEFL score of >79, they are eligible to apply for a renewable UC Global Transfer Scholarship for the duration of two academic years, which currently is set at US\$7,000 per year. To renew the scholarship for your fourth year of study at UC, you have to maintain a GPA of >3.25.

Academic Excellence

The University of Cincinnati ranks among the top 10% of universities in the U.S., and our Geography and Geographic Information Science program is one of the top 20 PhD granting programs. Professional Development

Thanks to a wealth of opportunities like co-op and internships, 2+2 students gain valuable work experience and income while completing their studies under the Curricular Practical Training program available for international students. After graduation, many students also take advantage of the Optional Practical Training program, which enables them to work in the United States fulltime in a company for 12 to 36 months.

Excellent Placement

Our 2+2 graduates are extremely competitive and well-placed. In the past ten years, many graduates attained offers from elite graduate schools around the country and abroad, including John's Hopkins, University of Pennsylvania, Carnegie Mellon, Cornell, Columbia, Cambridge, and London School of Economics. Others attained full scholarship (tuition and stipend) for their graduate studies in Ohio State University, Georgia Institute of Technology, and University of Florida, to name a few. 2+2 graduates with a GRE score of >300 and a high GPA are given priority consideration for admissions and financial aids if they prefer to stay in Geography at UC, and a few did remain to work with our faculty. For those

who want to join the work force, they often can find good jobs both in Cincinnati and other cities across America. One of our recent 2+2 graduates is currently making \$70,000/year in a New Jersey firm.
